Although this is an IML Feeder Contest, the winner is not guaranteed to travel to IML in May 2011. We will have specific guidelines and requirements for the winner. These must be met in order for him to move to the International Level Competition.

The focus of the contest is to select a Title Holder who will best represent the local community both locally and at other statewide contests. He will be required to work in conjunction with other clubs and organizations to raise much needed funds and awareness.

As we are all aware, the community is evolving. So is our Contest. Our intention is to select the best man to represent not only the leather community, but the leather/kink/fetish/gear community at large. A man who is community minded and focused on the betterment of the community.

This is not a "players" title per say, but more of a leadership and spokesperson title for the local Leather/Fetish/Gear community.

During the Interview process, no questions are out of bounds. The judges have been informed that contestants should have a basic understanding of leather/community/contest history and an understanding of what it means to be a Leatherman.
